

Sermon Questions for April 11, 2021

John 20:24-31

1. How would you explain the difference between DOUBT and BELIEF?
2. If there is power in belief, what can be said about doubt? Is doubt ever healthy? Explain.
3. What is it like to be around a positive thinker? What is it like to be around a negative thinker? Which are you?
4. Can you identify with Thomas's skepticism about the disciples' claim (v. 25)? Why or why not?
- 5 *When you believe you can achieve.* TRUE? Or FALSE?
6. Excluding the present, can you name a time in history when people have believed a lie? What impact did it have on history?
7. When have you believed in something that you later learned wasn't true? When have you believed in someone that you later learned wasn't truthful? How did you react to either? How has that experience impacted you?
8. Who have you known who exemplified truth? What made them so?
9. What do you think it means that Jesus is the Truth? (John 14:6)
10. What was the most meaningful or challenging part of this sermon for you? In what way will that make a difference for you?
