


Our Faith Promise "year" ends on February 10, 2019.

Wednesday Night: Join us January 23 6:00-8:00 p.m. for Wednesday night fun & games in the barn.




For those interested in learning more, the Orientation Meeting is Thursday, January 24, 6:00 p.m. IMPACT
