Making Disciples: Confirmation 2019

Jesus said, "Go therefore and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, and teaching them to obey everything that I have commanded you. And remember, I am with you always, to the end of the age." Matthew 28:19-20

How did Jesus make disciples? He did it by calling people to follow Him, by spending time with them, by sharing His life with them, and by allowing them to see and hear what it means to be His disciple. Like Jesus, we at Pierce Chapel are in the business of making disciples. In fact, we believe that that's our primary responsibility as a church.

Disciple-making starts young, and it continues throughout our lives. But there are certain points along the way when it's important to call people to commitment, to give them a chance to choose life as a disciple of Jesus Christ. The process we call Confirmation is an opportunity for young people to hear the call of Jesus and to respond intentionally while learning and growing alongside other disciples.

Below are the members of Pierce Chapel's 2019 Confirmation Class, along with their adult prayer partners and their students mentors who will be encouraging them throughout this 4-month journey. This year we also have four very dedicated Confirmation coaches/teachers, who will be leading the weekly teaching sessions, helping our confirmands explore what it means to be followers of Christ. Those coaches are Stephen Childers, Resa Lord, Gary Robinette, and Shannon Wooldridge. At the end of this 4- month period, each youth will have the opportunity to profess faith in Christ publicly (maybe for the first time, or maybe publicly acknowledging a spiritual decision they had already made), and to commit to being a disciple of Jesus Christ. Please pray that each confirmand will welcome God's work in their lives and experience God's deep love for them!
